

# 1633 Government Inquiry into Churchlands in Armagh

JAMES ARCHBISHOP of ARDMAGH and his tenants are seized and possessed of the whole cite and towne of Ardmagh, with the whole scite, circuit, precinct and lordshipp of the same, and also of all customs and towles of the marketts and faires, except such houses as belong unto the deane, dignitours, pryor, and vickars chorralls of the cathedrall church of Ardmagh, the abbot of the monastery of St. Peter and St. Paull, and the nunnery of Ardmagh.—All and singular the landes, lyeing and being within the lordship or mannor of Ardmagh, are in the said archbishop and his tenants full and free possession, as follow, viz.
